Dale was born on a farm near Horton in 1949 and has lived his entire life in Kansas. He moved to Topeka in 1965 and began bowling in 1966 at the young age of 17. He has 24 career 300 games to his credit, 7-800 series and numerous 700 series. He has a high average of 229. He has participated in the Topeka's Top Ten 23 times and a Champion of this tournament 3 times. He has been named "Bowler of the Year" in Topeka 5 times.

Dale is a champion bowler who represented his hometown, his state and his country in the sport of bowling. He received four Gold Medals from the 1977 FIQ tournament in Panama (With 18 countries competing) He won the Gold Medals in the 8-man, the 5-man, the 2-man and All Events. He was named Amateur Bowler of the World in 1977 by the Bowler's Journal. In 1979 he again qualified for the FIQ tournaments in the Philippines, where he won a Silver Medal in the team event.

Dale has competed in the ABC National Tournament 19 years. He is a member of the 1985 Team All Events title with a score of 9343, his team "The Pony Express" from St. Joseph's, Missouri. He is an "Eagle" member of the ABC National Tournament.

Dale has won many titles in the City, State, National and Regional levels, in Singles, Doubles, Team and All Events. He is a member of the TBA Hall of Fame.
