Serving as a Director of KWBA for twenty-two years at the time of her induction. Began bowling when the bowling center opened in Anthony. Helping with the organization of the Harper County WBA, at that time there were only four lanes at the center. In 1957 Georgia attended her first KWBA Annual Meeting which was held in Salina. Georgia served as association secretary, vice president and twenty years as president. Joined the KWBA board as a director, starting an AJBC program in Anthony, President, Bonnie Hodgson appointed Georgia to the Kansas YABA Managing Board as a representative of KWBA.

Georgia began teaching in Dodge City and later left her teaching career to become a Social Worker Harper County Welfare Department for a short time and became the Director advancing to supervisor of the Service Department in five (5) counties until she retired.

Georgia always entered the KWBA Woman's Championship Tournament, bringing tour buses of lady bowlers from Harper County each year to the tournament site.
