Jodie started bowling as a youth bowler but did not become a serious bowler until the age of 16 when she began bowling in an adult league. Jodie had won numerous City & State events. Her high game is 300. She bowled one in league and one in tournament. She has had 4 games of 299. She has rolled 40 games of 275 or better.

At the time of her induction her high series was 793. Jodie rolled 45 series of 700 or better. Her 1987-88 season average of 216 was tied for the second highest average in the nation.

The WIBC News published the leading 5-year composite league averages, Jodie's name was listed 7th with an average in the 84-85 season of 202, 85-86 season 212, 86-87 season 216, 87-88 season 211, and 88-89 season 212. A 5-year composite average of 210.60.

Jodie also competed in the traveling semi-pro Great Plains Bowling Association. Jodie was also a member of the Wichita State University Team which won a National Title.

Honored by being inducted into the Wichita WBA Hall of Fame in 1988.
