LeeRoy began bowling in 1929, in San Antonio, Texas. He served in the U. S. Air Force from 1941-1961 and retired as a Captain. He bowled on the service teams around the world.

Lee participated in all aspects of the game. He participated in the A. B. C. tournaments from 1936-1990. He bowled in the Topeka City tournament from 1955-1991. He bowled in the Kansas State Tournament from 1955-1991, till his health made him stop competing.

Lee was the Topeka Bowler of the year in 1959 and again in 1964, and another 300 game in 1983, at the age of 68. In 1990, at the age of 75, he carried a 203-composite average in league play. He was inducted into the Topeka Bowling Association's Hall of Fame in 1982. He has served on the Southwest Bowling council as a director.

Lee won several singles, doubles and team titles, both on the City and State level. These are too numerous to note individually. He was a quiet, respected gentlemen in the bowling community. He had an intense love for the sport of bowling, and we will miss his contributions dearly. We would like to thank Lee for all his contributions to the game of bowling.
