Mike began his bowling career in youth leagues in Leavenworth. His first statewide award was the Hi-12 Club for being one of the 12 highest youth averages in the state of Kansas. He represented Kansas in the All-American Youth Bowling Championship in Washington, DC where he won a \$1,000 Scholarship.

Mike has competed at the highest levels of bowling for the last 35 years, winning many tournaments at the local, state and regional levels. He was named Kansas City, Missouri Bowler of the Year in 1984.
