He has competed in 23 consecutive ABC/USBC National tournaments with a 300-game bowled in the 1989 National tournament in the doubles event, Mark Gingrich was his partner.

Mike is currently teaching at Wichita North High School where he is the head bowling coach. In 2004 his girls team finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in the first ever KSHSAA High School Bowling Tournament.
