Nelda started her bowling career in 1948 substituting for a lady who had an appendectomy. Nelda said, “It almost caused a divorce, but stuck with it and my husband has been one of my biggest fans and I hope I can bowl until I have to get in my wheelchair”.

Nelda was a member of the 600 club, averaging 180 plus for 10 years in the WIBC National Tournament. Won class A Doubles in KWBA Championship tournament in 1957, 1958, and 1959. Class A All Events in 1959 and Class O All Events in 1972. While bowling in the Ladies Scratch Doubles League at Meadow Lanes she bowled the highest 4 game series in modern records in the Topeka area 215-232-232-225 = 904 Scratch.

Nelda also served as President where she managed to increase their operating capital and gave them a guideline to follow. Her duties came first and at the same time she excelled in the ability to bowl. Nelda was inducted into the Topeka Hall of Fame in 1984.
