Terri has been a member of the Manhattan WBA since 1976 and has won Singles, Doubles and the Team Events plus winning Scratch All Events three times. She was Manhattan WBA Bowler of the Year six times.

Terri was Coach of the Kansas State University Bowling Team from 1976 to 1993 and has been the bowling instructor since 1982 to the present time. Terri also worked as an instructor for Manhattan Parks and Recreation Summer Program from 1994 to present. Instructed at Professional Bowling Camp 1981 and 1982. Instructed Coaches Training School for Special Olympics 1989 and 1995.

Terri bowled an 812 series in 1984, 757 in 1985 and a 712 in 1984. Her high game is 298 and high average was 203.

Terri had to quit bowling in 2000 due to health problems but she has continued to pay her dues and be active in the Manhattan WBA and K-State Bowling Program.

She helps with the City and State Tournaments and was inducted into the Manhattan Hall of Fame for Superior Performance in 2
