Bill was born in 1965 and has enjoyed Kansas his whole life. He began bowling at the age of 5 and had immediate success as he bowled a 299 game at the age of 1 in a Youth league at Southwest Bowl.

Bill has been a member of the Topeka BA board of directors for 13 years, where he served as director, Vice President for 6 years, and President for 2 years. He is currently a member of the Southwest Tournament board of directors as the Kansas representative. On the local level, Bill has accomplished many triumphs, including a 3-time TBA city Team Champion, 1-Doubles, 3 TBA Singles and 4 TBA All Events champion. Selected as Bowler of the Year in Topeka twice.

Bill has participated in 13 consecutive ABC/USBC National tournaments and 22 years in the annual KSBA championship tournament. Bill has 17-800 series to his credit with 833 being his high, 22-300 games (2 while on the PBA tour), 10-299 games and 1-298 game with a lifetime average of 233. Elected to the Topeka Bowling Association's Hall of Fame in 2002.
