Rich Black's accomplishments are legendary among those who have bowled in the state of Kansas, especially the "scratch" tournaments. He won the Kansas State All Star champion in 1967 and finished second in the State Singles event, the same year. In 1975 he finished second in All Events at the Nationals and 18th in Doubles. In 1978 he finished 16th in All Events and 6th in the Team event at the A. B. C. Nationals.

This year he represented the U. S. in the F.I.Q. world competition in Paris and London.

Rich won the 1987 Team event in the Kansas State Tournament, where he rolled a 300 game in the tournament. Rich has 16 -300 games to his credit, and 7-800 series. He is a six-time Wy-Jon city Team champion and a four-time Wy-Jon scratch All Events champion.

Rich's contributions and accomplishments in bowling will be greatly missed. We would like to thank Rich and his family for all their contributions to the sport of bowling.
