Robert M. Alstott "Bob" passed away March 18, 2010, at the age of seventy (70). He had lived in Joliet, Illinois most of his life, then later moving to Kansas, and finally to Florida.

During his bowling career he had competed on the Regional PBA tour, and the Senior PBA, and in the Kansas City area's finest scratch leagues.

He was a member of the well-known S&H Bowling Supply lineup, which posted some of the highest local and state scores ever.

Some of Bob's notable accomplishments include:

- 30-300's, 15-800's, including an 856 and 857.
- 1987 Kansas State Team Champion (3557) with Bob rolling a 704-675-740=2199 All-Events.
- 1977 Kansas State BPA Singles Open Champion, 1984 Wy-Jon City Team Scratch Champion (3226).
- 1980 Wy-Jon City Tournament Scratch All-Events Champion (1940).
- 2000 won a PBA Regional Senior Tournament in Ft. Walton Beach, Florida.

This Kansas State Hall of Fame honor is a fitting tribute to the bowling legacy of Robert "Bob" Alstott.
