Derek Frazier started in business in 1975 at Derby Bowl. His family purchased Seneca Bowl in 1982. Derek and his wife, Tanya, took over the daily operations of the business in 1998 when his Dad and Mom, Dale and Doris Frazier, retired. Over the years, Derek had the pleasure of working with many family members, including Dart, his brother, and his sons, Blaine, Jaden and Brayden.

During the 49 years in business, Derek served as SCBPA President and KSBPA President, along with many other bowling committees. He also served on the Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission Board and the Derby Chamber of Commerce.

Derek and the Frazier family made their centers available to host many of the Kansas State Tournaments. Derek was also instrumental in starting the High School Bowling program in Wichita and also throughout the State of Kansas.

Derek bowled in leagues for 49 years and competed in many City and State Tournaments with a high game of 300 - 3 times since December 2, 2004, 2 - 11 Strikes in a Row, and a High Series of 825 on December 2, 2004. His highest average carried since 2004 was 227 during the 2012-2013 season.

As we honor Derek for his years of Meritorious Service to the bowling community, Derek will join the Hall of Fame with his father, Dale Frazier, who was inducted for Meritorious Service in 2005.
