2023 CLASSIC CUP RULES

- 1. This tournament will be certified with USBC and is open to all Kansas USBC youth members in good standing and have not graduated high school.
- 2. Entry fee breakdown per person is as follows: \$35.00 per bowler. \$7.00 lineage, \$22.00 scholarship, \$2.00 awards, \$2.00 expense fee, \$2.00 state fee. KS State USBC will add \$1000.00 to the scholarship fund this year.
- 3. **ENTRY DEADLINE:** All entries must be postmarked on or before March 14, 2023.
- 4. **ELIGIBILITY:** All participants in the Classic Cup must have participated in Classic Team tournament to be eligible to represent their bowling center. All team members for classic cup must be current league bowlers from the center they are representing. Verification will be needed. Entries limited to the first 36 teams. Verification will be needed.
- 5. **<u>DIVISIONS</u>**: Teams can be any combination of boys or girls. Divisions may not be combined. Division 1 is any age of youth bowler in grades K 8th. Division 2 is any age of youth bowler in grades 9th 12th.
- 6. <u>DRESS CODE</u>: Boys are required to wear dress slacks and a collared shirt. Slacks must not contain drawstring waists or elastic bottoms. Slacks must have a zipper and a button to be eligible. Jeans are not permitted. Girls are required to wear slacks, skirts, capris, skorts or walking shorts. All skirts, capris, skorts or walking shorts must be below the competitor's fingertips when they are standing and their arms hanging loosely at their side. Jeans and yoga pants are not permitted. Participants will also be required to remove all hats and hoodies. USBC Rule 301b is also in effect.
- 7. **FORMAT:** Doors will open & check in will begin at 9:00am. Competition will begin at 10:00am. 10 scratch baker games. Top 4 teams return after lunch for best 2 of 3 elimination. Top 2 then advance to another best 2 of 3 to determine winner. All games are baker format. Lanes will be re-oiled after initial 10 games. All Classic Cup competition is scratch.
- 8. <u>AWARDS:</u> Scholarship will be awarded to the top 1 out of 4 teams and any fraction. Silver & Gold medals will be awarded to the top 2 teams. Winning team in each division earns possession of the Classic Cup Trophy for one year.
- 9. If bowlers arrive late, they must begin bowling in the frame being bowled on their pair of lanes, and will receive zero pins for the frames missed. Because of this, we encourage each team to have an available alternate on hand in case someone is unable to attend or gets injured. Alternate must come from the same bowling center.
- 10. The tournament director has the right to change rules at any time as well as make final judgements of all rules and issues.
- 11. Coaches and tournament director will have a meeting before competition to go over tournament rules regarding Classic Cup.
 - There is a \$30.00 fee for any checks returned for insufficient funds.
