Bonnie was inducted into the KWBA Hall of Fame in 1982 for Service.

Bonnie began bowling in early 1942. In 1948 she was elected secretary of the Salina WBA and served in that capacity until 1959. From 1959-1970 she served as the Salina WA President. Bonnie was a KWBA director from 1958-1967. In 1967 she was elected President of the KWBA. In 1966 she was appointed as a WIBC Director. She also became a WIBC Vice—President before her retirement.

Bowling was more than just a game for Bonnie, it became her way of life. With her work on the local, state and national levels. Countless hours were spent working on various report, new projects setting up committee and board meetings.
