He served on the Coffeyville BA board of directors continually in all capacities since 1970 including several terms as President, Vice-President, Secretary—Treasurer and Board member. He also served on the Independence BA as Director and was instrumental in combining the 2 associations when Coffeyville lost their charter due to fire in the Coffeyville Bowling Center.

Larry was appointed to the KSABA in 1979 serving southwest Kansas and maintained his directorship from that region until 1996 when he was elected Vice-President & then President. He also served on the KS Bowling Council and YABA managing board. He is a member of the SEK Ba Hall of Fame.
