2024 PEPSI YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. This tournament is certified by USBC and governed by USBC rules.
- League qualifying will take place Oct. 1, 2023 thru Feb. 29, 2024. Each league will hold one 2 week qualifying session between Oct.
 1, 2023 and Dec. 31, 2023 and a second 2 week qualifying session between Jan. 1, 2024 and Feb. 29, 2024. Advancement ratio from league to state is at least 1 for every 3 entries per category per qualifying session or any fraction thereof, including last place ties.
- 3. Bowlers may only bowl state finals once.
- 4. The tournament will be bowled in the following divisions.

- 5. This event is completely scratch with divisions based on age groups. For an additional \$5.00 you may enter an optional handicap event within your current division. Handicap is based on 90% of 210 for those entering handicap division. Scholarship will be paid based on a 1:4 ratio or any fraction of. There is no symbolic awards for the handicap divisions.
- 6. State competition will take place at Olathe Lanes East, 303 N Lindenwood Dr. Olathe on April 6-7, 13-14 & 20-21, 2024. Round robin match play finals for the U15 & U18 divisions will be Sunday April 28, 2024 at 10:00AM.
- 7. Entry Fee for State Tournament. Bowlers in the U8, U10 & U12 divisions pay \$30 (\$10.00 Lineage, \$2.00 awards, \$12.00 scholar-ship, \$4.00 expenses and \$2.00 state fee.) Bowlers in the U15 & U18 divisions pay \$40 (\$20.00 Lineage, \$2.00 awards, \$12.00 Scholarship, \$4.00 expenses, \$2.00 state fee.) AWARDS & SCHOLARSHIPS WILL BE RETURNED 100% TO BOWLERS. There is an extra \$4000.00 this year donated to our prize fund. We will break it down \$2000.00 for scratch division and \$2000.00 for handicap division.
- 8. <u>State Championships Format</u>: Bowlers in the U8, U10 & U12 divisions will bowl 3 games. Finals standings are based on the total pin fall of these 3 games. Bowlers in the U15 & U18 divisions bowl 6 games, moving one pair of lanes after each game.
- 9. <u>State Finals Format</u>: The top 8 male & female bowlers in the U15 & U18 divisions will return to Olathe Lanes East on Sun. April 28, 2024 at 10:00AM for the match play portion of the event. If a tie for 8th place exists after qualifying, the bowler with the highest single game will advance. State finalists will bowl 8 games of round robin match play. Bowlers will be awarded 30 bonus pins for each win 15 pins for each tie & 0 pins for each loss. PINS WILL CARRY OVER FROM QUALIFYING.
- 10. JR Gold National Championships. The male & female winners in the U12, U15 & U18 divisions will advance to the 2024 JR Gold National Championships. USBC will pay the advancers entry in the JR Gold National Championships. The advancers must have a USBC JR Gold membership or purchase one prior to the JR Gold National Championships. There is no requirement to be a JR Gold program member to enter the U12, U15 or U18 division at the local or state level.
- 11. Symbolic awards will be given as follows: <u>U8, U10 & U12</u> 1 our of 10 in each category will receive an award. <u>U15 & U18</u> All 8 bowlers in each category appearing in the round robin match play finals will receive an award. In addition awards will be given to the bowlers in each category (beyond 8th place) on a 1 out of 10 ratio or any fraction per category.
- 12. Scholarships will be given out on a 1:4 ratio or any fraction of.
- 13. This tournament will follow USBC Rule 301b, no wearing of or using bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, illegal substances, or inappropriate/gestures during competition. The following rules will also apply. No playing coin-operated amusement devices. No use of tobacco products or alcoholic beverages. No use of foul language or gestures. Participants will also be required to remove all hats and hoodies during the tournament.
- 14. Dress code is required for State finals held on April 28, 2024. Boys are required to wear slacks and a collared shirt. Girls are required to wear slacks, skirts, capris, skorts or walking shorts. All skirts, capris, skorts or walking shorts must be below competitor's fingertips when they are standing and their arms are hanging loosely at their side. Must also wear a collared shirt. Jeans and yoga pants are not permitted.
- 15. A bowler arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled on their pair of lanes. Frames missed will e credited with a zero. A bowler not present and ready to bowl when it is his/her turn will be credited with zero for that frame.
- 16. All matters not covered by these rules shall be determined by the Tournament Director.
